

Recipe of the month

Creamy turkey & sweetcorn crumble

Serves family of 4

3 turkey steaks, 1 tin of sweetcorn

25g flour, 25g butter, 600ml milk

125g oats, 75g self raising flour, 75g
butter, 75g grated cheese



Cook the turkey in the oven for approx. 20 minutes until the juices run clear.

To make the sauce, melt the butter and stir in the flour. Gradually whisk in the milk to make a thick sauce.

Cut the turkey into small pieces and add it to the sauce along with the sweetcorn. Place in an oven proof dish.

To make the crumble, rub together all the ingredients until it resembles breadcrumbs. Sprinkle on top of the turkey mix and cook in the oven at 200°C for 30 minutes.
