



This month's topic is **The Environment** and the colour we are learning about is **Green**.

During April, the children will be also be given the opportunity to join in and celebrate lots of different events. They include:

W/B 30th March - The children will be exploring the colour green. They will also be making cards and Chocolate Easter Nests for someone special to mark Easter on, Sunday 5th April.

W/B 6th April - The children will be learning about the nursery's local environment. We will also be getting active outside and learning about the importance of exercise to mark World Health Day 7th April.

Recipe of the month

Easter nests

200g milk chocolate, broken into pieces
85g shredded wheat, crushed
2 x 100g bags mini chocolate eggs

Melt the chocolate in a small bowl placed over a pan of simmering water. Pour the chocolate over the shredded wheat and stir well to combine.

Spoon the chocolate wheat into 12 cupcake cases and press the back of a teaspoon in the centre to create a nest shape. Place 3 mini chocolate eggs on top of each nest.

Chill the nests in the fridge for 2 hours until set.
